

## Indigenous Co-op Gathering at CMC Congress: June 8, 2026



Leaders from co-operatives established by and for Indigenous Peoples, will come together to share about their existing and future projects, and to collectively explore how to enable and promote economic resiliency and opportunities in First Nations, Inuit and Métis communities through the co-op model. Indigenous co-operators, Indigenous members of co-ops and associations, and non-Indigenous observers are invited to join our gathering to share and learn from each other, from coast to coast to coast. As a side event to Cooperatives and Mutuals Canada (CMC)'s Congress, this day will be an opportunity to discuss what the co-operative model has enabled across First Nations, Métis, and Inuit communities, opportunities for collaboration, and how we can shape the future together to build a stronger, Indigenous-led co-operative ecosystem.
